



Kumana – Bird-watchers’ paradise

A large sprawling natural edifice of rock outcrops and boulders, rock pools and drip-ledged caves dot the otherwise marshy environs of the Kumana National Park, one of Sri Lanka’s premier bird watching sites in an area known as Bambaragastakawa. The diverse landscape of Kumana, situated north of the Yala National Park, includes vast areas of reeds, supporting a diversity of birds and other fauna. Plans to upgrade existing jeep tracks into motorable roadways threaten to destroy this once peaceful National Park, and the livelihoods of those who depend on its unique ecosystem.
