



Dew and Sunlight

The morning sun filters through a thick canopy of dew-drenched trees in Sinharaja, Sri Lanka's best known tropical rainforest internationally recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a Man and Biosphere Reserve. It harbours a diversity of fauna and flora within its confines and boasts of breathtaking scenery spread over three administrative Districts. Parts of Sinharaja are still recovering from a 1970 government-sponsored logging programme. Current threats to its wellbeing include continuing human encroachment for agriculture, poaching and gem mining, actions that will inevitably destroy the invaluable ecosystem vital not only for the surrounding communities but also for the country as a whole.
